

Interscholastic Athletics and Extracurricular Programs

The Board sponsors a variety of interscholastic athletic competition, and extracurricular clubs and activities for district students. Because of the physical, educational and social value of interscholastic athletic and extracurricular programs, the Board encourages student participation in those programs. The purpose of this policy is to establish rules and regulations which protect the interests of the district, staff and students to insure that student participation is meaningful and rewarding for all involved.

1. The student shall be enrolled in school and be attending school regularly.
2. The student shall maintain a passing grade in all subjects to participate in athletic programs or extracurricular school-sponsored clubs and/or organizations.
 - a. ***Athletic programs*** include, but are not limited to:
 - (1) Football, volleyball, cross country, track, basketball, baseball/softball, wrestling, golf and cheerleading.
 - b. ***Extracurricular programs*** include all programs for which students do not receive academic credit:
 - (1) Examples - Associated Student Body (ASB) activities, class officers, drama, forensics and FFA.
3. The Board directs the administration to develop administrative rules and regulations for implementation of this policy.
4. The Board shall periodically review said administrative rules and regulations. Modifications shall be implemented on a need basis as a result of this review process.

Myrtle Point School District is a member of the Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) and the Board will adhere to the policies, rules and regulations of that body.
