## STUDENT RULES FOR TRAVEL

- 1. Students must check with each of their teachers prior to the trip regarding class work to be competed.
- 2. Students will return by the same bus unless (through prior school arrangement) written authority from parent or guardian permits an alternative.
- 3. Any student who is reported as uncooperative by the teacher and/or chaperon will not be allowed to take another school-sponsored trip during that school year.
- 4. All students will observe all regulations concerning proper conduct when using school vehicles:
  - a. Keep arms and hands inside the vehicle;
  - b. Remain seated when the vehicle is in motion;
  - c. Do not throw any material out of the vehicle;
  - d. Use containers for garbage, do not litter the vehicle.
