Student Achievement Program

The Board recognizes that the key work of school boards is to establish and promote a clear vision of student achievement as the top priority for the District. Student achievement may be defined by the District and may include, but not limited to, assessment results, student attendance and dropout rates, Certificate of Initial Mastery (CIM), Certificate of Advanced mastery (CAM) and diploma attainment.

The superintendent will ensure development and implementation of a comprehensive, collaborative process that engages the school community in the District's continuous student achievement improvement program efforts.

The District's program will be consistent with Oregon Department of Education requirements and reflected in school and District improvement plans.

The board will, in striving for continuous improvement of student achievement, annually review District and individual school data on student achievement, prioritize, allocate and realign resources as necessary.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations as needed to implement this policy.
