

Use of Feature Films/Videos and other Digital Media**

Prior to showing a feature film or other digital media in a school, the instructor must seek the written approval of the principal. At least five days prior to the showing, the instructor shall submit (in writing) to the principal the following information on the particular film:

1. Title and brief description;
2. Purpose for the showing;
3. Proposed date of showing;
4. When and how parents will be notified, or if necessary grant consent;
5. Audience rating (G, PG).

For feature films and other digital media with a PG (grade K-5), PG -13 (grades 6-8) or R (grades 9-12) rating, parents will be given an opportunity to request that their children be excused from viewing a film.

Instructors are encouraged to preview all film media before showing to students.

A parent may have the opportunity to preview a film when practicably possible and that parent must give prior consent before his/her child may view a film rated PG (grade K-5), PG -13 (grades 6-8) or R (grades 9-12) .

Edited or unrated films will be shown at the discretion of the building administrator.
