District Nutrition and Food Services

The Board recognizes that proper nutrition enhances student learning.

The Board directs that the district may participate in the meal program authorized by the USDA Food and Nutrition Service. Program participation shall be determined by the food service supervisor on a site-by-site basis within the federal guidelines governing the specific program.

The district shall complete a permanent program agreement with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) and shall submit a program update annually. The permanent agreement documents that the district shall comply with state and federal laws and regulations, guidance and instruction relating to the programs the district is operating.

Prior to implementation, the district shall submit to the ODE Child Nutrition Programs, any change of policy or procedure under the regulation of the USDA for these programs.

The district shall participate in the “offer” versus “serve” provision of the USDA programs for all students, preschool through senior high, housed in a district building with a cafeteria.

The district shall determine, below senior high level, on a site-by-site basis, “offer” versus “serve” or “non-offer” versus “serve” for students housed in buildings without a cafeteria.

The district shall serve as the school food authority (SFA). The superintendent shall serve as the legal representative of the SFA.

The Board directs the superintendent to develop administrative regulations as needed to implement this policy.
