At-Risk Student Program

The overall objective in addressing the educational deficiencies of at-risk students is to provide a positive environment conducive to the promotion of academic success whereby these students are no longer “at-risk” of failure to achieve or of dropping out of school. Partnerships between parents, local businesses, service agencies and the schools provide opportunities to mobilize the community and solidify efforts to eliminate the causes of student alienation from the home, school and the community.

Any student who has not acquired the knowledge, skills and attitudes needed to become a productive adult is at-risk.

Programs for at-risk students shall be planned and implemented with input from the community and parents of students to be served.

Opportunities shall be provided for parents to have regular meetings to formulate parental input if they desire.

Programs shall provide training opportunities to parents to build their capacity to improve their children’s learning in the home and in school.

Parents shall have the opportunity to participate in parent-teacher conferences with program staff.

Program information shall be readily accessible to parents.

Parents shall be encouraged to observe or participate as a volunteer in educational programs for at-risk students.
