Promotion and Retention of Students**

All students shall progress through the district's K-12 schools by achieving grade specific academic standards.

When a student is not making academic progress as demonstrated in grades, work samples, completed homework, test scores or performance tasks, the district, acting through its teachers, counselors, administrators and specialists, shall require that specific educational interventions or options be developed for that student. This plan shall be developed in cooperation with the parents of the student.

The school shall provide the additional opportunities for students to achieve academic standards by offering options or requiring participation in activities which may include but are not limited to:

1. Tutoring;
2. Modified class or school day schedules;
3. Extended school day or extended school week opportunities;
4. Summer school or vacation period school opportunities;
5. Grade retention.

It is the student's responsibility to apply himself/herself to the process of achieving academic standards. Grade retention may be required if other options have been refused by parents/guardians or their student or if those other options have proven unsuccessful in bringing the student up to the district's academic standards.

The superintendent is directed to develop administrative procedures for implementing this policy.
