High School Diplomas and Certificates

The Newberg School District issues the following diplomas and certificates:

- 1.0 Newberg High School Diploma. A high school diploma shall be awarded to a student who fulfills all State of Oregon and Newberg School District graduation requirements described in district policy.
- 2.0 Newberg High School Diploma with Academic Honors. A diploma with academic honors shall be awarded to a student who is eligible for the Newberg High School Diploma, completes certain specific academic requirements with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA, and meets Oregon University System entrance requirements.
- 3.0 Newberg High School Modified Diploma. A high school modified diploma shall be awarded to a student who earns a minimum number of credits through either modified regular education courses or through modified courses. The Newberg High School Modified Diploma is awarded to a student who is unable to meet the full set of academic content standards, even with reasonable accommodations, but who fulfills all requirements for the modified diploma as described in state, district and school policies.
- 4.0 Newberg High School Alternative Certificate. A high school alternative certificate shall be awarded to a student who does not fulfill State of Oregon and Newberg School District requirements for a diploma as described in district policy. This certificate may be awarded to a student with special needs or to an exchange student or to a student who is approved for this certificate by the Superintendent.
- 5.0 A Newberg High School Extended Diploma shall be awarded to students who have demonstrated the inability to meet the full set of content standards for a high school diploma with reasonable modifications and accommodations and who meet the requirements for eligibility as outlined in board policy.
