

Student Eligibility for Activities and/or Athletics

Students may be permitted to participate in extra-curricular activities and/or athletics in accordance with this regulation.

OSAA Sanctioned Activities/Athletics and Water Polo

1. Standards of Eligibility:
 - a. Full-time student: A student involved in OSAA-sanctioned activities or athletics or water polo must be enrolled in at least four classes during the present trimester (OSAA Rule 8-1);
 - b. Grade point average: The student must have earned a grade point average of at least 2.0 in the previous grading period;
 - c. Pass all classes: The student must have passed all classes in which he/she was enrolled the previous grading period.
2. Home School Students (OSAA Rule 8-5-1a)
 - a. District resident: Home school students wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities/athletics must reside in the district with their parent or legal guardian.
 - b. Registered with Willamette ESD: Home school students must provide documentation to the district that they are currently registered with the Willamette ESD.
 - c. Achievement test: Home school students must submit documentation to the district which demonstrates that they have achieved a minimum of 77percent or higher on the achievement tests.
3. Private School Students (OSAA Rule 8-5-1b)
 - a. District resident: Private school students wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities/athletics must reside in the district with their parent or legal guardian;
 - b. Full-time student: Students must be enrolled in at least 70 percent of class periods offered at the private school during the present grading period;
 - c. Grade point average: Students must have earned a grade point average of at least 2.0 in the previous grading period;
 - d. Pass all classes: Students must have passed all classes in which they were enrolled the previous grading period.
4. Probation: Students who wish to participate in activities and/or athletics whose GPA was between 1.5-2.0 in the previous grading period, or have earned a GPA of 2.0 and have no more than one failed class in the previous grading period are eligible for probation.

- a. Requirements: To be eligible to participate in activities and/or athletics, a student placed on probation must meet the following requirements:
 - (1) Sign a contract with the athletic director or the activity director indicating understanding of conditions and responsibilities of probation;
 - (2) Submit weekly progress report each Friday to the athletic director or the activity director;
 - (3) Maintain a GPA of at least 2.0;
 - (4) Be passing all classes.
- b. A student is eligible for probation only once during each school year.

District Activities/Athletics Not Sanctioned by OSAA

- 1. Standards of Eligibility
 - a. Grade point average: A student must have earned a grade point average of at least 2.0 in the previous grading period;
 - b. Pass all classes: The student must have passed all classes in which he/she was enrolled the previous grading period.
- 2. Probation: Students who wish to participate in activities and/or athletics whose GPA was between 1.5-2.0 in the previous grading period, or have earned a GPA of 2.0 and have failed no more than one class in the previous grading period are eligible for probation.
 - a. Requirements: To be eligible to participate in activities and/or athletics, a student placed on probation must meet the following requirements:
 - (1) Sign a contract with the athletic director or the activity director indicating understanding of conditions and responsibilities of probation;
 - (2) Submit weekly progress report each Friday to the athletic director or the activity director;
 - (3) Maintain a GPA of at least 2.0;
 - (4) Be passing in all classes.
 - b. A student is eligible for probation only once during each school year.
