Public Gifts to District or Individual Schools

Consistent with the laws of this state, the district may accept money or property donated for the use or benefit of the district and use such money or property for the purpose for which it was donated. The Board shall officially approve any gift valued at \$250 or more.

Tangible property contributed to the district becomes the property of the district and is subject to the same controls and regulations that govern the use of other school-owned property. Contributions of property or services that involve major costs for installation or maintenance, or initial or the continued financial commitment of school funds, shall be presented for the superintendent's consideration and approval.

Any group planning to raise funds for a gift to a school or the district educational system shall first consult with the principal or superintendent regarding what kind of gift should be made as per Board policy KI – Fund Raising and Solicitation. Priority lists of needed and desirable equipment, supplies or services shall be kept in each school.

Requests to accept gifts or donations to create staff positions or reinstate positions that have been eliminated or reduced shall be reviewed by the superintendent. Any acceptance of such gifts or donations shall be approved by the Board.

All gifts or donations to the district shall be subject to the provisions of Board policy. In accepting gifts, whenever possible the Board shall attempt to achieve equity among schools.

The superintendent shall develop administrative regulations for the acceptance of gifts of materials, equipment or funds to the district.
