

Admission of Part-Time Private School Students

1. The principal will establish the approximate number of private school students that their respective programs can accommodate based on available space.
2. Admission applications must go through the principal's office.
3. Student educational and behavioral records will be obtained and reviewed prior to admission.
4. Initial admittance and annual renewal must be approved by the superintendent.
5. In-district, full-time and part-time students will be given preference over private school students.
6. Only private school students who live within district boundaries will be considered for class enrollment.
7. Students who request to participate in extracurricular activities in grades 9-12 must meet eligibility requirements for programs administered by the Oregon School Activities Association.
8. Junior High athletics are imbedded into our 7th period Physical Education (P.E.) class and curriculum. Private school students - and home school students - who wish to participate in junior high athletics must submit registration forms for North Lake School District to participate in 7th period P.E. activities. This enrollment does not obligate home-schooled students to any school testing.
