

## **Intradistrict Transfer Students**

With the superintendent's approval, the district may grant the request of a resident student to attend another high school, provided the receiving school agrees to that request.

Students who attend a district school identified for improvement, corrective action or restructuring under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 may, as required by law, transfer to another public school in the district which has not been identified for improvement or as persistently dangerous. Additionally, students who attend a district school identified as persistently dangerous, or who are victims of a violent criminal offense occurring in or on the grounds of the school the student attends, may transfer to a safe public school in the district that has not been identified as in need of improvement.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations, as necessary, to implement this policy.
