

Authority of Handbooks and Publications

As a result of collective bargaining, meet and confer discussions, and statutory requirements, a number of handbooks and publications have the same authority as Board policy or administrative regulations.

Furthermore, the District administration is authorized to publish and issue to staff, students, and parents other handbooks, such as school rules. Such publications will, however, be subordinate to policy, regulations or the above list of supplements. While the administration will make an effort to inform staff and students of policies, regulations, and rules, it is also expected that staff and students will make an effort to read and study the publications. Continuous or flagrant disregard for policy, regulation, or rule may be considered insubordination and cause of discipline.
