

### Recruitment of Licensed Staff

The superintendent will develop and maintain a recruitment program designed to attract licensed personnel to the district.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent, with the assistance of other district administrators, to determine the personnel needs of the district and to locate suitable candidates to recommend for employment by the district.

The search for licensed staff members may extend to a variety of educational institutions and geographical areas. Those factors considered will be the diverse characteristics of the district and the requirements of the district affirmative action plan and programs.

Present employees are encouraged to apply for any position for which he/she meets the stated requirements.
