Interdistrict Transfer of At-Risk Students

The Board authorizes the superintendent of schools to accept the non-resident district student who is identified as an "at-risk" student when, in the judgment of both superintendents, the placement will benefit the educational growth of the student. An at risk student is defined as a student who has identified and documented problems with behavior, attendance, substance abuse, academics and/or who is a victim of student abuse and/or other conditions as deemed appropriate by the superintendents.

The authorization for acceptance must be approved by the superintendent of the sending district and the superintendent of the receiving district.

Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent.

Placement of a student will be reviewed at the conclusion of each school year and extended only on the joint approval of both superintendents.

In the matters of the transfers, the superintendents will complete the appropriate forms for the transfer of basic school funds.
