

Elimination of Drugs and Alcohol on District Premises

The district shall publish expectations and develop procedures that eliminate the use of drugs and alcohol on district premises. However, concern for drug and alcohol use extends beyond school premises.

Each year the district shall include in the student/parent handbook or code of conduct clear statements of expectations and consequences should a student use drugs or alcohol on school premises. Students and parents shall be informed that unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a student or minor within 1,000 feet of school property is a Class A felony. Punishment is a maximum of 20 years of imprisonment, \$100,000 fine, or both.

The district shall record incidents and report the findings to the Board in September of each year.
