

### Vandalism/Malicious Mischief

1. No person shall willfully damage or injure any district property or threaten or willfully injure any student or staff member.
2. Any student who violates the above may be disciplined, suspended or expelled.
3. The amount of damage to any district property shall be determined through procedures established by the Board and may be assessed against the student willfully causing the injury or damage and against the parent(s) or guardian having legal custody of the student.
4. If the assessed damages are not paid as demanded, the Board may bring an action against the student and the parent(s) in a court of competent jurisdiction for the amount of the assessed damages not to exceed \$7,500 plus costs.
5. Certain records may be withheld for failure to make restitution for assessed damages.

The Board will seek all legal remedies against persons found to have committed such acts. Full restitution for the damage will be sought from such persons, or, in the case of minors, from their parents. Certain records may be withheld for failure to make restitution for assessed damages.

Students who willfully destroy district property through vandalism/malicious mischief or arson, who commit larceny or who create a hazard to the safety of other people on district property will be suspended in accordance with state law and the Board's policy on student suspensions and referred to law enforcement authorities.
