Management of Transportation Services

Any school pupil enrolled in North Santiam School District 29J is entitled to transportation to and from school without charge if his/her home is on a designated bus route and he/she meets the bus at designated pick-up points, or is certified as handicapped under school board regulations and is in need of transportation. Students K-8 who live more than one mile of their resident school are eligible for transportation. For students in grades 9-12, the distance is 1-1/2 miles. Students who live a mile or a mile and a half may also be required to meet busses at designated bus stops the same distance described above. The District may pick students up less than these mileage amounts if the state has certified upon district application, that there is an unsafe condition.

The North Santiam School District 29J operates all busses in accordance with rules and policies as established by the Oregon State Department of Education and by mutual agreement of North Santiam School District 29J.

The responsibility for pupil transportation rests with the local Boards. However, the Boards has assigned full responsibility for the transportation system to the Superintendent of the District who is directly responsible and accountable to the School Board.

The Superintendent may delegate certain responsibilities to the Transportation Contractor regarding pupil transportation.
