21st Century Schools Councils

The North Santiam School District board directs the Superintendent to encourage community involvement in shared decision making and to foster the collaborative efforts of district personnel, students, parents, and community members through Oregon's Educational Act for the 21st Century Schools Council Committees.

A 21st Century Schools Council shall be established at each school. The duties of the 21st Century School Council shall include:

1. The development of plans to improve the professional growth of the school's staff;
2. The improvement of the school's instructional program;
3. The development and coordination of plans for the implementation of programs under the 21st Century Schools statute at the school.
4. The administration of grants for the professional development of teachers and classified district employees.
5. Although the above are required site council duties, other duties may be assumed if agreed upon by a site council and administration.
6. Although the above are required site council duties, other duties may be assumed if agreed upon by a site council and administration.

It is intended that administrative procedures shall provide parameters and guidelines for each school council.

Nothing in this policy shall interfere with the duties, responsibilities and rights of the duly elected school district Board or the administration's right to manage the schools.

21st Century Schools Council shall not supersede the Federal, State or School District authority and shall follow the requirements of the Public Meeting Law.
