Students with Disabilities

Students kindergarten age through 21, living in the District, which have been evaluated by qualified educational and/or medical personnel and found eligible for services or programs for students with disabilities shall be provided a free and appropriate public education. The District will determine whether a student is both eligible for and in need of special education services.

Special Education and Related services will be provided to meet each student with disabilities needs as specified in that student's Individual Education Program (IEP).

The Board directs the Superintendent to ensure procedures for the implementation of special education services and programs are developed by the District or through agreements with the Willamette Education Service District and conform to with the requirements of state and federal legislation. Such procedures will be retained in the parent-student handbook consistent with the policies and procedures as approved by, and on file with, the Oregon Department of Education.
