

Alternative School Programs

In addition to the regular curriculum and courses offered, it is possible for students to obtain credit from the following activities:

1. Approved community college coursework;
2. Approved correspondence courses;
3. Winema Alternative School;
4. Approved educational travel;
5. Proficiency tests;
6. Passage of an approved drivers' education course;
7. Independent study (during the regular school day under classroom teacher guidance);
8. Night school;
9. Tutoring;
10. Work experience;
11. Credit recovery; and/or
12. Credit earned through online school.

The high school will grant diplomas to persons who have previously left high school and now wish to complete the diploma requirements.

The following criteria will be used:

1. The total credit and/or competency requirements will be the same as that of the person's graduating class;
2. Credit will be awarded for military service if the person can produce a copy of an Honorable Discharge. The person will then be granted one physical education credit and one general elective for the first year of service. An additional two general elective credits will be granted for a second

year of service. Additional credits can be granted, upon proof of specialized training, at the discretion of the counselor and the administration;

3. Credits earned at community colleges, specialized training schools, night school, etc. can be credited towards a diploma following an evaluation by the counseling department of the high school.
