

Computer Instruction

In addition to instructional materials and audiovisual materials, an increasing field of technological aids and equipment are becoming integral parts of districts' instructional programs. Computers, telecommunications equipment and laser technology all have a variety of applications across the curricula. To ensure that maximum benefits are realized from the investment required for the equipment, the following policies will apply:

1. The primary purpose of microcomputers at Stayton High School will be for instruction. Included in instructional uses will be CAI (Computer Assisted Instruction), CMI (Computer Managed Instruction), computer literacy, and computer programming.
2. Computer users will recognize and adhere to existing copyright laws.
3. Computer hardware and software may be removed from school premises by staff when proper paperwork has been filed.
4. All hardware purchased must be durable, use a wide range of software, be compatible with other school hardware, and have readily obtainable maintenance.
5. All software must be previewed by a staff member before purchase.
6. All purchases of software will be coordinated through the Media Center to avoid unnecessary duplication. Hardware purchased shall be coordinated through district technology personnel. A catalog of school software will be available.
7. The district will provide computer training for all staff appropriate to their assignment.
