

## Evaluation of Instructional Programs

The purpose of evaluation of instruction will be:

1. To determine educational needs and provide information for planning.
2. To indicate instructional strengths and weaknesses.
3. To check on the suitability of programs in terms of community requirements.
4. To show the relationship between achievement and the system's stated goals.
5. To provide data for public information.

The Board will rely on the professional staff to provide continuous evaluation of the educational program and instructional processes. The Board may participate with the professional staff in such evaluation; it may also arrange for evaluations to be carried out by outside agencies.

Appropriate research studies will be periodically reviewed to determine recent trends and developments in evaluation techniques.
