

Relations with Law Enforcement Agencies

Whenever a law officer wishes to confer with or question a student at the school, the principal or his/her designee shall be present at the meeting or as directed by the law officer, and an attempt will be made to notify the student's parents.

The student may be removed from school by a law officer or an authorized representative of the Services to Children and Families. School administrators will notify parents of such action by phone or written communication unless given different direction from a Services to Children and Families employee.

Outside agencies may deliver subpoenas and warrants to students in the presence of an administrator.
