**Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drug Prevention Program\*\***

The district's Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drug (ATOD) Prevention Program includes K-12 prevention instruction; a public information program for students, parents and staff; and intervention and referral procedures. The district's jurisdiction includes all school-sponsored events and activities. Parents, teachers, school administrators, local community agencies, juvenile authorities and the drug/alcohol service community must be consulted in the program's development as provided by law.

The district acknowledges that ATOD use by students is illegal and harmful, and endorses a drug-free school and a drug-free workplace.

The Board will annually review, update and adopt an age-appropriate ATOD prevention curriculum consistent with the State Board-adopted Common Curriculum Goals to be taught annually to all K-12 students. Basic information and instruction activities will comply with OAR 581-022-0413.

The district will annually provide information regarding the district's prevention and intervention policies, consequences for violation of these policies and information regarding referral to students, parents and staff. Drug-related medical emergencies will be handled as a serious accident or illness. The procedures to be taken will be included in the district's comprehensive first-aid/emergency plan and ATOD guidelines.

The district will continue to plan for the access and use of federal drug-free school funds.

Policies, rules and procedures will be reviewed and updated regularly.

Staff development activities will inform all staff of the district plan and their responsibilities within that plan. These activities will include ATOD prevention education to all staff.
