Cocurricular/Extracurricular Activities

The Board will maintain a student activity program appropriate to the maturity of students and as varied as staff and facilities permit. The program will be designed to offer to as many students as possible, worthwhile athletic and leisure-time interests, wholesome recreational and social activities and opportunities to develop skills in cooperation.

Cocurricular or extracurricular activities conducted under the jurisdiction of the district, requires the supervision of school personnel.

A student must be either enrolled as a full-time equivalent student at a district school or be a home-school student residing within the district boundaries, and must meet all other district and Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) eligibility requirements to be eligible to try out for membership on a district athletic team or district activity(ies). Activities designed to garner community participation are exempt from this policy.
