Cocurricular/Extracurricular Activities

The Board will maintain a student activity program appropriate to the maturity of students and as varied as staff and facilities permit. The program will be designed to offer to as many students as possible worthwhile athletic and leisure-time interests, wholesome recreational and social activities and opportunities to develop skills in cooperation.

Supervision: Whenever or wherever held, when conducted under the name of the school or district or any class or organization thereof, cocurricular/extracurricular activities will be under the general supervision of school personnel.

It is the intent of the Board that district-sponsored extracurricular activities be scheduled at times other than Wednesday evening and Sunday.

Such activities may be scheduled for Wednesdays and Sundays, providing the uniqueness of the event and minimal conflict would be generated for the participating students, and consequently would warrant and require the appropriate principal's consideration and necessary approval.

A student must be either enrolled as a full-time equivalent student at a district school or be a home-school student residing within the district boundaries, and must meet all other district and OSAA eligibility requirements to be eligible to try out for membership on a district athletic team or district activity(ies). Activities designed to garner community participation are exempt from this policy.
