Special Use of School Buses

The general philosophy of the Board is that transportation equipment purchased by the district is to be used primarily for school purposes and taxpayers should not expect to rent or use busing equipment or personnel for civic or fraternal purposes.

However, school bus services may be used for student field trips and activity purposes.

Individual or private groups may not use buses or vans when such is not of general benefit to the district or community unless granted special permission by the superintendent. Permission may be granted following submission of a written request. Factors to be considered by the superintendent include, but are not limited to, the number of district school-age students served and whether the program or activity provided one the district is supportive of but unable to provide, either by personnel requirements or financial restrictions. Each usage must be applied for on an individual basis. Individuals or private groups who receive permission to use buses or vans will be required to pay for their own gasoline.

Drivers must have valid CPR and first-aid cards, submit proof of insurance and have participated in the training required to drive a district van.
