Recruitment of Licensed Staff

The superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the screening of all licensed personnel applicants for positions in this school district.

The selection of all licensed personnel shall be approved by the Board upon the recommendation of the superintendent. Should a person nominated by the superintendent be rejected by the Board, it shall be the duty of the superintendent to make another nomination.

License

Unless licenses are verified by the district, the district requires licensed staff to submit copies of all license endorsements to the superintendent's office. It shall be each licensed staff member's responsibility to keep all endorsements current and received by the superintendent's office.
