Talented and Gifted Program

The district is committed to an educational program that recognizes, identifies and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted students. Talented and gifted students are those who have been identified as academically talented and/or intellectually gifted.

The Board will cause to be established written identification processes for identifying academically talented and intellectually gifted students K-12.

A written plan (Pupil Education Plan/TAG Plan) that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students shall be similarly developed.

The district will make an effort to identify talented and gifted students from special populations such as:

1. Cultural and ethnic minorities;
2. Disadvantaged (economic and otherwise);
3. Underachieving gifted;
4. Disabled learners.

Careful selection of appropriate measures and collection of behavioral or learning characteristics shall be used.

The district may also identify and provide programs for students who demonstrate creative abilities, leadership abilities or unusual abilities in visual or performing arts.

The Board has established an appeals process for parents to utilize if they are dissatisfied with the identification process of their student for the district program for talented and gifted students and wish to request reconsideration.
