## Use of Feature Films/Videos\*\*

The unauthorized showing of copyrighted films/videos is prohibited in the district as a classroom or extracurricular activity.

The Board recognizes the showing of commercially produced and rated feature films and videos may have a legitimate purpose in a school's education program.

The following guidelines will be used when an employee wishes to show a film/video that is not prohibited by copyright laws.

Prior to showing a feature film/video in a school, the instructor must seek the written approval of the building principal. At least five days prior to the showing, the instructor shall submit to the principal (in writing) the following information on the particular film:

1. Title and brief description;
2. Purpose for the showing;
3. Match with course objectives;
4. Proposed date of showing;
5. Audience rating (G or PG).

Instructors are required to preview all film media before showing to the students.

Only films/videos rated G or PG may be shown as part of the school program. A parent may have the opportunity to preview a film when possible. PG-13 must have written parental consent prior to viewing.

Edited or unrated films/videos will be shown at the discretion of the building administrator.

Films/Videos that are supplied through the Malheur Education Service District are not subject to this policy.
