## Immunization Policy

In accordance with Board policy JECA - Admission of Resident Students, parents will be expected to submit, within 10 days of first admission of their student/students to district schools, a statement to school authorities regarding their student's/students' immunization to certain childhood diseases.

In the event that no statement is submitted within the 10 day limit, the building administrator/designee shall contact the parents and attempt to secure such statement. If parents refuse to cooperate by providing the required information, the student may be excluded from school and the case will be referred to the superintendent for further action.

In the event the immunization record indicates that deficiencies in immunizations exist, parents will be required to begin correcting these deficiencies within 10 days of receipt of the record. Failure to take corrective action may result in exclusion of the student from school and referral to the superintendent and/or Nyssa School District Board of Trustees.

This policy shall be applicable for all students K-12, and all new students transferring to the district at other grade levels.
