Transcript Evaluation

The district recognizes the importance of transcript evaluation to determine the value of credits earned, number of years of school attendance and placement for students transferring to district schools from other public, private or alternative schools, including those who have been receiving home school instruction.

Transfer credits and attendance may be accepted or rejected at the discretion of the district consistent with Oregon Administrative Rules. Validation of credit may be required.

Credit for Independent Study, Work Experience, Research and Off-Campus Experiences

Credit may be granted for successful completion of independent study, work experience, research and off-campus experiences meeting district guidelines. The student must request prior approval from the high school principal through the counselor, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.

Credit by Examination

Credit and student placement shall be granted for successful completion of accepted, designated performances representing a stated course of study. Implementation shall be dependent upon the designing and administering of examinations that identify competencies and course objectives. Any requirement to enroll and pass a successfully challenged course will be waived. No distinction will be made between granting credit and waiving course requirements. The student must request prior approval from the high school principal, through the counselor, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.
