Student Vehicle Use

All students who drive vehicles to school are subject to the following:

1. All student parking shall be in the parking lot along Adrian Boulevard. All other parking areas are off-limits to student parking during school hours;
2. All cars are to be parked properly in parking stalls. Do not park parallel to, or on the sidewalks. Parking in other areas is permissible only for emergencies. **Parking regulations will be strictly enforced;**
3. All students must be licensed and covered by insurance. The district is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents;
4. There will be no reckless driving on the school grounds. Students will not ride on the outside of vehicles or in pickup beds. This is the driver's responsibility.

The penalty for the first infraction of #4. shall be immediate removal of driving privileges for a total of 30 school days. A second violation will result in loss of privileges for the entire school year. The student may appeal penalties to the superintendent;

5. Students will not be asked or allowed to use private cars for any district business by any district employee. Should students be asked to use a private car by an employee, they should immediately report the incident to the high school principal or the superintendent.

Consequences for Inappropriate Driving or Parking Behavior

1. The student resource officer will be contacted and a citation issued when Oregon laws are broken.

2. The seriousness of the offense will determine which of the following penalties will be used:
 - a. Warning and notification to parents;
 - b. Loss of driving privileges for 30 days;
 - c. Loss of driving privileges for the school year.
