2. Provide professional advice and counsel to the Board and to any committees established by Board action;
3. Implement the management function to ensure the best and most effective learning programs through achieving such sub-goals as:
 - a. Providing leadership in keeping abreast of current educational developments;
 - b. Arranging for staff development necessary to the establishment and operation of learning programs that better meet more learner needs;
 - c. Coordinating cooperative efforts at improvement of learning programs, facilities, equipment and materials; and
 - d. Providing access to the decision-making process for the ideas of staff, students, parents and others.
