Disposal of District Property

Except for property that can be traded in on new equipment, the Board intends that district property will be held for use throughout its useful life and disposed of either for salvage value or junk when the property no longer can be efficiently and effectively repaired or used legally. The decision to dispose of equipment will be made by the supervisor in charge of the equipment. The superintendent will be given a list of the equipment being considered for disposal and will inspect the equipment before final approval for disposal is given.

Salvageable property has some value and will be advertised and sold at public auction for sale or advertised for bid and sold to the highest bidder.

Junk property has little or no salvage value and may be discarded when the cost and frequency of repair is excessive, the equipment or material becomes obsolete or the material is broken or damaged beyond repair. Junk property may be disposed of at the county disposal site.

Property may be donated to non-profit organizations or legitimate recycling businesses; however, Board approval is required for all donations.
