

Student Transportation in Private Vehicles

Transportation of students will be by the district's transportation system or by a district employee's automobile, properly insured, except as provided below.

Parents may be permitted to use private vehicles to transport students other than their own on field trips or other school activities under the following conditions:

1. The school administrator has approved the activity;
2. A permission slip signed by each student's parents has been received by the principal or his/her designee granting permission for the student to participate in the field trip and to ride in a privately-owned automobile;
3. The parent or other adult driving the automobile is properly licensed to drive and has the automobile liability insurance required in the state of Oregon and verification has been made that the adequate number of seat belts is available;
4. An adequate number of seat restraints are available and the adult driver requires their use.

The district will develop procedures to implement this policy.
