Infection Control - HIV, AIDS, HBV

The district shall use standard precautions at all times for infection control. Each person is therefore treated as though an HIV, AIDS or HBV* infection exists.

The district shall develop an Exposure Control Plan that includes infection control procedures for staff and students.

Staff shall receive an annual in-service and students information that includes correct procedures for cleaning up body fluid spills and for personal cleanup, immunization and personal hygiene, as well as the location and a content review of first-aid and clean-up kits. Kits shall be available for each room in the building and in each district vehicle.

In addition to an annual in-service, staff and students on a regular basis will receive HIV, AIDS and HBV information.

The information shall emphasize infection - how infection is spread as well as how it is not spread.

The district will cooperate with Oregon Department of Education, the Oregon Health Division, the local health department and/or the education service district, as appropriate, in delivering HIV, AIDS and HBV education.
