Curriculum Development

The Board believes it necessary that the district continually develop and modify its curriculum to meet changing needs in technology and fields of knowledge and to assure the full, rounded and continuing development of our students. While keeping with the requirements of state law, the Board authorizes the superintendent to review the curriculum periodically and to advise the Board on curriculum changes needed.

Recommendations to add new courses or programs or to delete existing courses or programs must be approved by the Board.

Curriculum guides and course outlines will be provided for all courses offered in the district. Planned course statements will be on file for each course offered in grades 9-12. Information regarding course offerings and course descriptions in grades 7-12 will be provided to all students and interested patrons of the district.

The curriculum of Oakland School District is designed to provide students a range of preparation in academic areas as well as in developing values and behaviors in interpersonal relations, exploring leisure time activities, preparing for the world of work and acquiring the broad spectrum of skills necessary for success in life.
