

District Athletic Eligibility

The Board believes that participation in district athletics complements, reinforces and extends academic programs and offers opportunities for students to grow physically, intellectually and socially. Participation is a privilege, not a right, and students are expected to meet and maintain district eligibility standards in order to participate. Failure to meet and maintain academic achievement, satisfactory attendance and desirable behavior, as measured by district criteria, may result in discipline including probation, suspension and/or removal from the activity.

As a member of the Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA), in all activity matters, the district will adhere to OSAA policies and rules and the rules of the State Board of Education.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.
