Alternative Instructional Programs

The district will allow students to enroll and obtain credit through a variety of alternatives such as approved summer school, correspondence course, credit by exam or college classes. Credits are given on a semester or full year basis, depending on type of courses being taken.

Prior approval of the high school principal must be obtained if the alternative credit is to be used to meet graduation requirements. It is the student's responsibility to arrange for a transcript to be sent to the highschool after completion of any alternative program taken for high school credit. Three quarter hours are equal to one-half high school credit.
