

Use of Tobacco

All students shall be made aware of Board policy JFCG through orientation programs, student handouts, posters or other reminders. Student violation of the policy shall be dealt with by the principal or his/her designee in the following manner:

1. Upon seizure of a tobacco product, the parent will be notified;
2. If the student is on probation, the county Juvenile Department will be notified by written report from the school in all cases of tobacco possession;
3. A report of the incident will be completed and placed in the student's behavior file;
4. Upon the first such violation, the student and parent will be offered a choice of either:
 - a. The student's attendance and successful completion of a tobacco/smoking/addiction education program that meets minimum program standards as recommended by the ADAPT and other public agencies; or
 - b. The school will submit a report of the violation to the county Juvenile Department.
5. Upon the second or subsequent violation, a report will be submitted to the county Juvenile Department;
6. The student may, in addition to the above, be suspended from school activities for a period of time consistent with other district rules governing student conduct;
7. Further violations could result in suspension or expulsion.
