Public Communications Program

The residents of this district are interested in their schools as an extension of their homes, an extension which exists to perform a special function in the development of their children; therefore, the Board will make every attempt to:

1. Keep the public informed about the policies, administrative operation, objectives and educational programs of the schools;
2. Provide the means for furnishing full and accurate information, favorable and unfavorable, together with interpretation and explanation of the school plans and programs.

In meeting these goals, the Board will place great importance upon the role of individual staff members as communicators and interpreters of the school program to parents and the general public. Further, it is recognized that there are times when direct communication between school officials and the community is necessary; at such times, the Board will encourage and provide these opportunities.

The superintendent will encourage the use of procedures and techniques for assuring a continuous and free-flowing line of communication between the staff and the district's residents.
