Board Member Removal from Office

The Board shall declare the office of a director vacant upon the happening of any of the following:

1. The death or resignation of the incumbent;
2. When an incumbent is removed from office or his/her election hereto has been declared void by judgment or decree of any competent court;
3. When an incumbent ceases to be a resident of the district;
4. When an incumbent ceases to discharge the duties of his/her office for two consecutive months unless prevented therefrom by sickness or other unavoidable cause; or ceases to discharge his/her duties for four consecutive months for any reason;
5. When an incumbent is recalled from office by district voters.

When a vacancy occurs in the office of a director, the clerk shall call a meeting of the remaining (member or) members of the Board who shall select a person from any of the qualified voters of the district to fill the vacancy. The director so selected shall serve until June 30 following the next annual election. If the office of a majority of the directors of the district is vacant at the same time, the Education Service District Board shall select persons to fill the vacancies from the qualified voters of the district.
