

Admissions to District Events

All spectators in the district will be assessed the uniform district rate for extracurricular activities. Spectators are defined as patrons who attend extracurricular activities for the purpose of entertainment.

Exceptions to the above are as follows:

1. Senior citizens (those 65 or older) will be admitted free;
2. Three Rivers League and Oregon High School Coaches Association passes will be honored;
3. Volunteers (doctors, fire department, police department will be admitted free;
4. Unpaid officials who perform frequently at athletic events (scorekeepers, public address personnel, photographers);
5. Children under age six, accompanied by an adult, may be admitted free.
6. The Superintendent may approve a rate for a family pass and may approve discounted rates for special events.

District staff will be admitted at no charge in order to promote employee participation in district extracurricular activities. Admission will require employees to show their School District ID card and be willing and available to assist with supervision if called upon.
