

## Resuscitation Decisions

The district values the contributions of all students to the overall success of all educational environments; therefore, no employee of the district shall comply with any parental request, written or verbal, for nonresuscitation of a student. The district defines “resuscitation” as an attempt to restore breathing and/or a pulse.

In a life-threatening situation, district staff will dial 911 for paramedic assistance and resuscitate any student requiring it in order to sustain life until relieved by paramedics or other appropriate medical personnel.

Resuscitation techniques shall not be used in cases where the district has on file a physician-signed “DNR” (Do Not Resuscitate) order accompanied by a signed parent/student of majority request for the DNR order.
