

## **Curriculum Adoption**

### **District Supported Curriculum, Programs, and Strategies**

In order for a curriculum, program, or strategy to be officially supported, an appropriate administrative body, e.g., elementary administrators, secondary administrators, or district curriculum committee, has recommended that the CPS is available to schools that wish to use it. The recommendation is forwarded to cabinet for consideration. If approved, some financial support is made available and the district provides staff development as appropriate. Typically, district supported CPS's are adopted by a building and then used by all teachers in that building.

### **Supplemental Curriculum, Programs, and Strategies**

Teachers may use supplemental materials to support adopted curriculum, programs, and strategies. However, the adopted CPS must remain primary. Supplemental materials should be selected according to district policy and guidelines.
