

Early Entrance**

Kindergarten

The district will adhere to the state policy of admitting to kindergarten those five years olds whose fifth birthdays occur on or before September 1, and no later than September 30, of any year.

First Grade

The district will admit to first grade all six year olds whose sixth birthdays occur on or before September 1 of any year.

A student will be admitted into the first grade if his/her sixth birthday occurs on or before September 1, as established by law. In addition, a student whose sixth birthday occurs after that date may be admitted to the first grade if he/she:

1. Is a first grade student transferring from a public school in another district, or from a private school;
2. Completed a successful year in a public kindergarten the previous year and would be continuing his/her formal education.

Early entry into school will be allowed for a student whose fifth/sixth birthday occurs after September 1, but not later than September 30 and whose needs would best be met in the school program based on an analysis by qualified professional staff of his/her:

1. Cognitive development;
2. Social development;
3. Physical development.

The Superintendent shall identify screening processes and instruments which will provide a dependable assessment of the preceding criteria.

Parents will be required to pay the cost of the special testing involved.
