¹Student Tuition and Fees

Tuition amounts and fees for students residing in the Collins-McDonald Dormitory will be set according to a student's residency status as follows:

Non-Oregon Resident Students and F-1 (Foreign Exchange) Students

¹**Annual Tuition amount:** \$12,000 to be paid prior to school starting. Said tuition amount will cover:

1. Room and board in Collins-McDonald Dormitory for a period beginning no earlier than August 15th and ending no later than June 25th (10 1/3 months);
2. Instructional costs (and books) for courses offered in the current school year schedule;
3. ESL prep classes;
4. Computer classes;
5. Educational activities and field trips (excluding meals) as part of a class learning activity;
6. Transportation costs to and from airports on initial arrive and final departure;
7. SAT testing (first test only).

¹**Additional Fees.** The district will charge the student for additional costs, if applicable:

J-1 Foreign Exchange Students

Tuition is paid to Foreign Exchange Agency. J-1 Foreign exchange students fees to agency will cover:

1. Room and board in Collins-McDonald Dormitory for a period beginning no earlier than August 15th and ending no later than June 25th (10 1/3 months);
2. Instructional costs (and books) for courses offered in the current school year schedule;
3. ESL prep classes;
4. Computer classes;
5. Educational activities and field trips (excluding meals) as part of a class learning activity;
6. Transportation costs to and from airports on initial arrive and final departure;
7. SAT testing (first test only).

Oregon Resident Students Living in Collins McDonald Dormitory

Monthly room and board at Collins McDonald Dormitory: Room and board to be paid in advance of the 1st of each month. Paid to the order of Paisley School District. Two months in arrears will result in the student losing placement in the Collins McDonald Dormitory. \$200
