Community Use of District Facilities

The primary use of Prairie City Schools is to meet the educational needs of their students. Therefore, uses of the district buildings which are part of the educational program will have priority over requests for the use of district facilities by non-school community groups. The Board, however, believes that district buildings should be available, whenever possible, to non-profit, non-discriminatory community groups for purposes related to the social, cultural, recreational and educational needs of the entire community, when such uses do not interfere with the student's educational program. The Board has, therefore, adopted the following regulations for the use of district facilities by such groups.

The district buildings shall be available during non-school hours for the following purposes: instruction, lectures, civic affairs, cultural, political, charitable, social meetings or events, entertainment events, athletic activities and for similar purposes which will enhance the general welfare of the community.

Final authority for determining which groups may use the district facilities shall rest with the Board or its designee.
